Abstract

The seminar explores Kochenov and Ganty's concept of "EU Lawlessness Law," which examines how the European Union employs various legal techniques to prevent violations of the rights of racialized non-citizens—ranging from equality and dignity to the right to life—from being recognized as breaches of EU law. It analyzes how this system operates, how it is financed, how it withstands legal scrutiny, and what purposes it ultimately serves.
